

Disinfectants and Prevention Strategies for MRSA!

How do we control MRSA (methicillin-resistant staphylococcus aureus)?

All equipment shared with soldiers and civilian personnel (i.e. gym equipment, teaching equipment in a class room or in a field environment, etc.) must be wiped down by the individuals using it. It must be cleaned with a disinfectant by the person about to use it and after the person has finished the task or exercise.

The following is a recommendation for keeping all equipment free of germs.
