- _____ 3. Proof of ASVAB GT score of at least 110
- _____ 4. Height/weight certificate
- _____ 5. Current APFT card
- _____ 6. Class 1A Flight Physical stamped “qualified” by Ft. Rucker
(valid for 1.5 yr.) No physical profiles. No exceptions.

Warrant Officer Candidate Requirements:

- _____ 1. NGB Form 62 (completed by the unit)
- _____ 2. Federal Recognition form (completed by the unit)

Additional Instructions:

- 1. Each individual applicant is responsible to build his/her own packet by gathering all of the required documents as listed above.
- 2. After all of the documents above are collected, send one copy to the unit, one copy the State Aviation Office, and keep a copy for yourself.
- 3. Individual is responsible for keeping packet up-to-date (i.e. flight physical, APFT card, height/weight certificate).
- 4. The State Aviation Office must have a complete packet on file before a flight school quota is requested.
