- 4. JUSTIFICATION: The 153rd Military Police Company request one (1) 92Y MOSQ Soldier to provide logistical support for new equipment, basic issue items (BII) and components fielding. The unit has recently been fielded (14) Mine Resistance Ambush Protected All-Terrain Vehicles (MATV).
