  - c. Understand and complete daily quality assurance plans for catered meals
  - d. Comprehend and make recommendations for Statement of Work for meals
  - e. Correctly complete all necessary/required food service forms
- f. Random inspections of contracted meals, contractor required documentation, and contractor procedures
