Get Help Finding and Paying for Child Care.

Air Force Child Care Fee Assistance was created to provide authorized Active Duty personnel assistance in locating, selecting, and offsetting the cost of civilian child care when on-base child care is not available, or a viable option for the service member and their family. The programs available through Child Care Aware® of America provide subsidies for eligible military dependents enrolled in quality commercial child care programs throughout the United States. Child Care Aware® of America authorizes subsidy amounts based on total family income for those eligible Air Force families, and supplies monthly payments directly to the prospective child care provider.

Before submitting an online application for child care subsidy, please visit http://militarychildcare.com/ first in order to make your requests for military sponsored child care. If you do not have access to an on-base child care provider after you have made your requests, then you may be eligible to participate in one of the child care fee assistance programs.

Parents: Some items to determine your eligibility. You must:

- 1. Be in one of the following status:
 - a. Active Duty
 - b. Reserve/Guard Active Duty
 - c. US Air Force Dual Status Technicians
 - d. Survivors of Combat Fallen Warriors
 - e. Active Duty Wounded Warriors
- 2. Select a Qualifying Program & Child Care Provider
- 3. Collect and Submit Necessary Supporting Documents
