## SPECIALTY SUMMARY

Pilots mobility aircraft and commands crews to accomplish airlift, airdrop, training, and other missions.

- Plans and prepares for mission. Reviews mission tasking, intelligence, and weather information. Supervises mission planning, preparation, filing a flight plan, and crew briefing. Ensures aircraft is preflighted, inspected, loaded, equipped, and manned for mission.
- Pilots aircraft and commands crew. Operates aircraft controls and equipment. Performs, supervises, or directs navigation, in-flight refueling, and cargo and passenger delivery.
- Conducts or supervises training of crewmembers. Ensures operational readiness of crew by conducting or supervising mission specific training.
- Develops plans and policies, monitors operations, and advises commanders. Assists commanders and performs staff functions related to this specialty.

## TRAINING REQUIREMENTS:

- For entry into this specialty, completion of Air Force Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training (SUPT).

## ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Applicants must have a qualifying score on the Air Force Officer Qualifying Test (AFOQT), IAW AFMAN 36-2032 to apply for this position. AFOQT can be scheduled by contacting Base Training at (302) 323-3422.
- Graduate from Total Force Officer Training (TFOT) and enter formal Undergraduate Pilot Training (UPT) prior to their 33rd birthday (selections will be based on availability of TFOT and UPT class dates).
- Must be able to pass FC 1 Flight Physical.
- Must be able to attend an in-person interview mid-January 2026.

**Following initial screening, applicants will be contacted for interview if considered for Undergraduate Pilot**
