SPECIALTY SUMMARY:

Commands Cyberspace Operations Squadron. Direct and monitors activities to ensure seamless integration of cyberspace operations resources for Air Force operations.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Commands squadron. Directs cyberspace operations including DoD Information Network operations, defensive and offensive cyberspace operations activities. Coordinates squadron and staff activities pertaining to unit personnel and information management, financial and supply management, planning, and programming to ensure accomplishment of unit mission. Ensures cyberspace operations requirements are met, unique systems are accredited, and operators are weapons system/mission certified for secure and reliable operations. Monitors cyberspace operations activities. Monitors and evaluates effectiveness of activities and functions, training programs, readiness of personnel, and operation and adequacy of activities. Ensures necessary operations are conducted to provide command and control, secure and non-secure voice and data, and other battle space effects.

SPECIALTY QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be fully qualified in the 17S3A AFSC.

Other:

For award and retention of this AFSC, specialty requires routine access to Tier 5 (T5) information, systems or similar classified environments and completion of a current T5 Investigation IAW DoDM 5200.02_AFMAN 16-1405, Air Force Personnel Security Program. Award of this AFSC may require completion and favorable adjudication of a cyber-aptitude assessment. Retention of this AFSC may require favorable adjudication of counter-intelligence polygraph and/or favorable determination for access to sensitive compartmental information.
