- 3. Soldier Qualifications:
- a. Experience preferred: Previous experience working within Recruiting and Retention and administrative action support
  - b. Skills/Qualifications Preferred: Current CLS training
- c. Minimum Military and Civilian Education Required: Military driver's license and civilian driver's license
- d. Passing score required on most recent ACFT and must meet HT/WT standards IAW AR 600-9
- 4. Positions of Significant Trust Requirements state and NGB Levels:

## a. State Level Checks/Requirements (COL (06) Appointing Authority):

- (1) Must be able to produce a favorable National Agency Check with Law and Credit.
- (2) Must complete a Department of the Army Sensitive Duty Assignment Eligibility Questionnaire (DA Form 7424).
- (3) Must not be listed on the National Sex Offender Public Website, (http://www.nsopw.gov) verified and signed by the interviewing agency.
- (4) Must provide written consent that authorizes Department of Defense to access criminal history record information for POSTA and receive favorable results from the Nationwide FBI Database digital fingerprint capture system check. This check is completed by the State Security Manager.
  - (5) Must complete a DD Form 369 for use in Police Records check.

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- (6) Must complete, and provide, a favorable Behavioral Health Interview (DA Form 3822).
- b. <u>NGB Level Required checks (POC ARNG-GSS/HRP)</u>: Must have favorable results showing no Type I or Type II offenses as listed in Annex A, HQDA EXORD 193-14. Additional screening will be accomplished by ARNG-GSS/HRP through:
  - (1) Department of Army Inspector General
  - (2) Criminal Investigation Division
  - (3) Office of Military Personnel File including Restricted Fiche Review
  - (4) Army Substance Abuse Program
- 5. Project Justification: Provide R&R support. This will include but not limited to:
  - a. Interview and prospect prospective enlistees
  - b. Transport Soldiers to MEPS for processing and shipment to BCT/AIT
  - c. Area canvassing to support mission
- d. Advise applicants of disqualifications which require waivers and assist with preparation of waiver application(s)
  - e. Assist in maintaining monthly communication with RSP Soldiers
  - f. Conduct prospecting IAW NGR 601-1 to support lead generation
