<u>Find a Risk</u>— Are processes and procedures performed in accordance with applicable procedures?

Fix a Risk—If not, why not? Notify and discuss with chain of command. Identify required changes.

Document a Fix-

Implement changes and document to prevent from future occurrence.

USAP Fundamentals

- USAP is a part of the Wing Commander's inspection program (CCIP).
- It is an opportunity for Airmen to report noncompliance with Air Force policy or instruction.
- Assists leadership with root cause identification and corrective action implementation.
- Required by AFI 1-2 and DAFI 90-302.
