**POSITION DESCRIPTION:**

17Y3 Cyber Effects & Warfare Operations. These individuals are subject matter experts and respected advisors to leadership, offering insights into the employment of both offensive and defensive cyber operations assets and personnel. They are responsible for orchestrating, managing, and integrating cyberspace technical capabilities, delivering critical technical recommendations across various military and inter-agency platforms. Their role involves integrating cyberspace capabilities into warfighting functions to enhance combat effectiveness and maneuvering strategically in the Cyber Domain to exert pressure on adversaries both offensively and defensively. Furthermore, they champion the training and guidance of cyber personnel, providing both individual and collective instruction. They are instrumental in establishing and evaluating Joint Qualification Requirements (JQRs), Joint Qualification Standards (JQSs), and Joint Cyberspace Training and Certification Standards (JCT&CS).

**TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Applicants must hold a Senior Level Proficiency in one of the United States Cyber Command work roles of EA, DNEA, ION, Capability Developer, or Fires Planner, as defined in the Joint Cyber Commander and Control for Readiness (JCC2-R) program, which will be verified prior to the board.

**ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS:**

***- Applicants for appointments as Warrant Officers in the ANG must have a minimum of one (1) year of satisfactory service by 01 December 2024 in the grade of E-5 or above.***

***-To be eligible for an original appointment the applicant must be at least 18 years of age and not reached his/her 42d birthday. Current ANG members can use adjusted age. Must be able to complete 10 years of commissioned service.***

***-Applicants who have waivers for any part of the AF Physical Fitness Assessment are ineligible to apply.***

***-Must be a United States citizen.***

**TRAINING REQUIREMENTS:**

If selected, candidates can expect to start Warrant Officer Training School (WOTS) between June and August of 2025 at Maxwell AFB, Alabama.
